 - *Recurrent training from certified training centers; full motion simulator training and ground instruction (every six months for captains; annually for first officers)*
 - *Emergency situation training*
 - *International procedures and security training*
 - *Airport-specific training (for destinations such as Aspen, London City, etc.)*
- *Fully trained and licensed mechanics (A&P, IA)*
- *FAA Dispatch-Licensed Flight Coordinators*
- *Company-wide OSHA training program*
- *Company-wide initial and annual safety and security training program*
- *Trained Emergency Response Team*

Our full-time, dedicated Manager of Safety, along with Flight Operations and Maintenance Operations Safety Representatives, are responsible for ensuring all flights run smoothly and safely.  - *These rigorous auditing programs are undertaken by the leading industry vendors and international industry auditing associations. Meridian is proud to meet and exceed the standards set by these organizations. We hold:*
 - *ARG/US Platinum Rating*
This is the highest level of ARG/US safety ratings and is awarded to those operators who meet all the criteria for Silver and Gold, and have also passed a rigorous on-site safety audit. Meridian has held this rating level since 2012, and is one of only 135 ARG/US Platinum Operators worldwide.
 - *Wyvern Wingman Rating*
Meridian has been Wyvern Wingman certified since the standard's inception in the industry. The one-day on-site audit is conducted every 24 months to verify compliance. Less than 100 operators worldwide currently hold the Wingman rating.
 - *International Standard for Business Aircraft Operations (IS-BAO) Stage 2 Certification*
 - *IATA Third Country Operator (TCO) Approval*
