Subject: Ban on Carriage of Hoverboard Devices

Effective immediately, Meridian Air Charter and Aircraft Management has decided to ban all makes and models of 'Hoverboards' from our aircraft. Due to the potential safety risks associated with the lithium-ion batteries used in these devices, including spontaneous ignition or explosion, these devices shall not be permitted in the aircraft cabin or luggage compartments. Devices with the battery removed, present the same risk and therefore will also not be permitted on board Meridian aircraft.

This ban is in line with the restrictions placed by many airports and aircraft operators. If any regulations or guidance from an aviation authority are made known, Meridian will review and amend this policy to reflect regulation, guidance, and/or industry best practice.
